## **Contact Hours Certificate from Action for Healthy Kids**

Continuing education credits, in the form of contact hours, are available from Active Schools' home organization, Action for Healthy Kids. There are a maximum of 29 contact hours available during the week. The number of contact hours you receive will be based on the trainings for which you choose to participate and required signatures from those trainers to verify your participation. Action for Healthy Kids/Active Schools will issue you a certificate of contact hours completed.

## **Graduate Credits from the University of Northern Colorado**

The University of Northern Colorado, through Brian Dauenhauer, PhD, Association Professor and Director of the UNC Active Schools Institute, is offering one or two graduate credits. Requirements will include attending at least 12.5 hours of trainings sessions (1 credit) or 25 hours of sessions (2 credits) and completing the following types of post-event work: (1) for each session you attend, identify key messages and most valuable information and how you will apply that to your work, (2) reflect on the entire camp experience, (3) design a plan to continue your professional development over the next 1-3 years, and (4) connect with at least three professionals you met that you will continue to engaging with after camp.

Cost: \$100 for 1 credit; \$200 for 2 credits
